SENIOR CRISIS WORKER: Kainai Women's Wellness Lodge

Position Summary: The Senior Crisis Worker is directly responsible to the Manager with the following duties and responsibilities. Supervision of staff and provide informal and formal feedback, evaluation and coach staff. Make recommendations to the Manager in all areas of needs with staff, clients and shelter.

- Create, maintain and report on program statistics required for monthly and annual reports and proposals including issues/trends and challenges.
- Oversee effective and efficient delivery of our Intake and Assessment program in providing: telephone, virtual and/or in-person intake; risk assessment and safety planning; short-term support; coordination of resources and services of individuals impacted by family violence.

Qualifications: Human Services Degree or diploma or Crisis Worker certificate; (3) three years' experience working in a related family violence or related field.
